And be it enacted, No contractor, supervisor Not to be paid without certification or laborer shall be paid any thing for his work on the roads, unless he obtains a certificate from the Board of Road Commissioners, with the affidavit of a road commissioner attached thereto, certifying that the work for which he is to be paid has been faithfully done, and that the holder is entitled to the amount of money which he claims; and said Board of County Road Commissioners shall, before entering upon the discharge of their duties as such, make oath or affirmation before a justice of the peace for said county that they will issue no such certificate, unless they believe the same to be just and proper, and have personally examined the said work for which the same is issued, which oath or affirmation shall be filed with the Board of County Commissioners for Calvert county; and any road commissioner issuing any such certificate without having personally inspected the work, shall be deemed guilty of a
