To audit and settle the accounts Arundel county, be and they are hereby authorized and directed, to audit and settle the accounts of Thomas Perry, Oliver Perry, Samuel Smith, Thomas Nutwell, Samuel Thomas, Edward Owens, Edward Prout, Phillip Prout, Isaac Nutwell, Mercer Owens, Albert Starlings, Thomas Owings, and Beal Owings, for expenses cost incurred in attendance in the United States District Court of Maryland, in the year eighteen hundred and seventy-two; and upon final settlement of the same to pay to said named parties the respective amounts due thereon.

Authorized to pay or levy SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That said commissioners be and they are hereby authorized, in their discretion, to pay or levy for the expenses and defence of the registers and judges of the last election in said county, who have been indicted in the said United States District Court.

In force.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 362.

AN ACT to repeal section thirty-one, of article twelve, Code of Public Local Laws, title "Harford county," sub-title, "County Commissioners," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Repealed and re-enacted Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section thirty-one, of article twelve, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Harford county," sub-title "County Commissioners," relating to the salary of the clerk to the County Commissioners, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Sec. 31. He shall receive such annual salary as the County Commissioners shall direct, not exceeding the sum of five hundred dollars.
