

toll for traveling on said road; provided, said toll shall not exceed the following rates to wit: One and one-half cent per mile for every vehicle drawn by one animal; for any vehicle drawn by two animals three cents per mile; and for every vehicle drawn by more than two animals, one and one-half cent per mile for every additional animal; for every score of sheep or swine or neat cattle, five cents per mile; for every horse and rider, and every lead or driven horse, one and one-half cent per mile.

Rates of toll

SEC. 8. *And be it enacted*, That every person who, to avoid the payment of the legal toll, shall turn out of said road or pass any gate thereon, on grounds adjacent thereto, or wilfully misrepresent the distance he or she has traveled or intend to travel, the person so offending shall, for every such offence, pay to the President and Directors of the said company the sum of twenty dollars, and the said sum may be sued for and collected in like manner as similar debts are now sued for and collected; and if any toll-gatherer shall knowingly demand and receive any greater toll than he is authorized to receive by this act, he shall forfeit ten dollars for every such offence, for the use of the county.

To avoid payment

Penalty

SEC. 9. *And be it enacted*, That if any person shall injure or destroy, or obstruct any part of said road or the property of the company, or forcibly or fraudulently pass any gate thereon without first paying toll, he shall be subject to indictment in the Circuit Court of the county, and upon conviction of such offence shall be punished by fine.

Injure or destroy

SEC. 10. *And be it enacted*, That persons using the said road shall keep on the right hand side thereof, leaving the other side clear and free for other vehicles to pass and re-pass.

Keep on the right hand

SEC. 11. *And be it enacted*, That the Directors of said company shall have power to make and adopt such by-laws, rules and regulations for the direction and management of said company, as may in their judgment be necessary for the purpose of their incorporation, not inconsistent with the provisions of this charter and the laws and Constitution of this State; and the President and Directors of said com-
