With the following amendment:

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

Section 1, line 6, after the word "estate" insert "any goods, chattels, lands, tenements, rights and credits."

Line 8, after the word "debts" insert "with the right to appear in person or by attorney and to defend as in other suits."

Which were adopted.

Said bill, as amended, was then read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
