wherein such vacancies may occur; also, provided, that the said Board of Special Police shall always consist of two members from Harford county and one from Cecil county.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take in force. effect from the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 385.

AN ACT to repeal section two of article thirtyseven, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "evidence," sub-title "competency of witnesses," as amended by the act of January session, of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, chapter one hundred and sixteen, and to amend and re-enact the same.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section two, of article thirty-seven, re-enacted. of the Code of Public General Laws, title "evidence," sub-title "competency of witnesses," as amended by the act of January session, eighteen hundred and sixtyeight, chapter one hundred and sixteen, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments, to read as follows:

2. When an original party to a contract or cause original party of action is dead, or shown to be lunatic or insane, is dead. or when an executor or administrator is a party to the suit, action or other proceeding, either party may be called as a witness by his opponent, but shall not be admitted to testify on his own offer or upon the call of his co-plaintiff, or co-defendant, otherwise than now by law allowed, unless a nominal party merely; provided, that when an executor or administrator, Proviso. guardian or committee of a lunatic or insane person, is a party to the suit, action or other proceeding, when the cause of action has arisen on a contract made
