

## CHAPTER 398.

AN ACT further to amend and enlarge the powers conferred upon the Roman Catholic Archbishop of Baltimore, and his successors, by the act entitled "an act relating to the manner of holding and transmitting the title to certain church property therein mentioned," passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-two, chapter three hundred and eight, and by the supplement thereto passed at January session, eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, chapter two hundred and sixty-eight, entitled an act to amend and enlarge the powers conferred by the act, entitled an act relating to the manner of holding and transmitting the title to certain church property therein mentioned, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-two, chapter three hundred and eight, so as to permit the said corporation sole, to sell and convey the property held under said acts, as may be expedient.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Roman Catholic Archbishop of Baltimore, for the time, and his successors forever, shall be and they are hereby authorized and empowered at their discretion, to dispose of, lease, sell and convey from time to time, the whole or any portion of any lots or parcel of land, which said corporation sole, now has, or hereafter may acquire, in the same manner, and to the same extent, that any private person or other corporate body, could or might dispose of, lease, sell or convey property by him held or possessed.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
