

SEC. 158. The property, real and personal, of all railroad companies which shall duly pay into the treasury the said annual tax on gross receipts as aforesaid, shall be exempt from taxation for State purposes. Shall pay annual tax.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 409.

AN ACT to repeal section one hundred and ninety-three, of article three of the Code of Public Local Laws, of Baltimore county, sub-title "Sheriff," passed at the January session of the Legislature in the year eighteen hundred and seventy-two, chapter fifty-nine, and to re-enact the same so as to read as follows:

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section one hundred and ninety-three, of article three, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Baltimore county, sub-title "Sheriff," passed at the January session of the Legislature of Maryland, in the year eighteen hundred and seventy-two, chapter fifty-nine, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows: Repealed and re-enacted.

SEC. 193. The Sheriff of Baltimore county shall be allowed two dollars and fifty cents a day for each day he shall attend the Circuit Court for said county, in person or by deputy, when said court is actually in session, and shall be entitled to charge and receive the sum of forty cents, and no more, per day for keeping and boarding each prisoner committed to or confined in the jail of said county; this part of this act to take effect and go into operation at, upon and immediately after the expiration of the term of office of the present Sheriff of said county.
