

CHAPTER 418.

AN ACT to add an additional section to the charter of the City of Cumberland, authorizing the Mayor and Council of Cumberland to purchase or condemn additional ground, for the use of said city, for market-house and station-house.

Authorized and empowered

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Mayor and City Council of the City of Cumberland are hereby authorized and empowered to purchase such additional property as they may think necessary, for the purpose of enlarging the accommodations of the market in said city; and in case that they cannot agree with the owners of any property that they may desire to obtain, or in case that the owner thereof is an infant, or married woman, *non compos mentis*, or absent from the State, then they may proceed and condemn the said property in the same manner as they are now authorized to condemn property for the opening or extending any street or alley in said city; provided that the costs of said property shall not exceed twenty thousand dollars.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 419.

AN ACT to repeal sections ninety-four, ninety-five and ninety-six, of article twenty-one, Public Local Laws, entitled Washington county, and relating to fences.

Repealed.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That sections ninety-four, ninety-five and ninety-six, of article twenty-one, entitled Washington county, relating to fences, be and the same is hereby repealed.
