should said swine be claimed by the owner or owners thereof, he, she or they shall pay twenty-five cents for every day said swine has been impounded, together with the fine and costs as prescribed in the first section of this act, and in default of payment of the said fine and impounding fee, the said swine may be sold to satisfy the same.

Fine shall be applied

SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That the fine imposed and collected under this article shall be applied, one-half to the informer, and the balance to the paving of streets in the village of Knoxville, under the supervision of the justice of the peace, by whom such fine was collected.

In force

SEC. 5. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 421.

AN ACT to add sub-sections to article two, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title Anne Arundel county, sub-title Annapolis, to provide a Board of Police Commissioners for Annapolis city.

Repealed

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the following sub-sections be and they are hereby added to article two, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title Anne Arundel county, subtitle Annapolis, and all sections or parts of sections relating to Annapolis, inconsistent with the provisions of the following sub-sections, are hereby repealed and declared inoperative, and all powers and provisions in the charter and code of said city, in reference to police are also hereby repealed.

Sub-Section A. On the first Monday of May, eighteen hundred and seventy-four, the Governor of the State shall appoint three persons, residents of the City of Annapolis, one for two years, one for four
