Proceed to hear consider and determine

sess the benefits and damages arising, happening and ensuing from the opening, constructing and grading of said proposed street, avenue or alley, and make a true return thereof, in writing, to the commissioners of Baltimore county, with the names of the persons to whom benefits have been allowed or damages assessed, and the amount so allowed for benefits or damages as aforesaid; but, before said persons, so appointed, proceed to act in the premises, they shall give ten days' notice of their intention so to do, by publication thereof in one or more newspapers published in Baltimore county, which notice shall state the time, place and object of their meeting; and after the return of said examiners has been made to the Commissioners of Baltimore county as aforesaid, the said commissioners may proceed to ratify and confirm, or reject and set aside said report and return; provided said report and return have been filed for thirty days in the office of said commissioners; and provided, said commissioners, before proceeding to act in the premises, shall cause notice of the filing of said report, return, etc., to be published, for three consecutive weeks, in one or more newspapers published in Baltimore county; and unless objections, in writing, to said report and return, are filed by some person interested in the premises, or his, her or its agent or attorney, within the period aforesaid, in which case the said county commissioners shall, as soon as convenient and practicable thereafter, and after five days' notice to the parties interested, or their agents or attorneys, or five days' notice, posted on the premises in case the owner is a non-resident or is not known, proceed to hear, consider and determine said objections, and the report and return of the examiners and all the proceedings in said case, or may in their discretion, send back to said examiners or to a new board of examiners, in case they deem it advisable, the award, return, report, plat and proceedings of said examiners, for alterations, corrections or amendments, and any person interested in said proceedings, may appeal from the final order of ratification or rejection of report of said examiners by the county commissioners of said county, to the circuit court thereof; provided, said appeal is taken within thirty days from the passage of said final order of ratification or rejection; and provided
