of the Comptroller and Treasurer, sixteen dollars and seventy cents; to Hamilton H. Powers, one hundred and thirty-seven dollars and fifty cents, erroneously paid into the Treasury as per certificates of the Comptroller of the Treasury, Treasurer and Attorney General.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 444.

AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners of Baltimore county, to grant rights of way through the jail lot of said county, to the Towsontown Rail Road Company, and to the Maryland and Pennsylvania Rail Road Company.

Authorized to grant rights of way.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Commissioners of Baltimore county, be and they are hereby authorized to grant rights of way through the jail lot of said county, to the Towsontown Rail Road Company, and to the Maryland and Pensylvania Rail Road Company, of a width of thirty-three feet for the first of the abovenamed railroads, and of the width of thirty-five feet, for the other; the said rights of way to be used for railroad purposes only.
