CHAPTER 447.

AN ACT to refund to Jer. Dyer, one of the firm of Penn and Dyer, and J. Dyer and Company, and to Thomas J. Hall and Company, and to Townsend, French and Company, moneys erroneously paid as outage and storage on tobacco.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Comptroller of the Treasury be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue his warrant upon the Treasurer in favor of Jer.
