#### CHAPTER 458.

AN ACT to authorize the Board of Police Commissioners for the City of Baltimore to appoint a clerk to the Marshal of Police for said city.

Appoint clerk  
to Marshal of  
Police.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Board of Police Commissioners for the City of Baltimore be and they are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to select some suitable person to act as clerk to the Marshal of Police for said city, at a salary of twenty-five dollars per week, payable semi-monthly; and the said clerk, before entering upon the duties of his office, shall enter into bond to the State of Maryland in the penalty of two thousand dollars, conditioned for the faithful discharge of his duties as such clerk; the said bond to be approved by the said Board of Police Commissioners.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
