

CHAPTER 459.

AN ACT to repeal an act passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and seventy, chapter fifty-nine, entitled an act to direct the Attorney General of the State to cause the State of Maryland to be made a party in a cause now pending in the Circuit Court of Baltimore city, entitled the "Commonwealth of Virginia *versus* the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Company," and others.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the act passed at the January session of eighteen hundred and seventy, chapter fifty-nine, entitled an act to direct the Attorney General of the State to cause the State of Maryland to be made a party in a cause now pending in the Circuit Court of Baltimore city, entitled the "Commonwealth of Virginia *versus* the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Company," and others, be and the same is hereby repealed; provided, that this act shall not apply to pending cases. Repealed.

CHAPTER 460.

AN ACT to repeal section twelve, of article sixty-four, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "mortgages," and to re-enact the same with amendments.
