SEC. 4. *And be it enacted,* That the sixth section, of the act of eighteen hundred and thirty-four, chapter eighty-seven be re-enacted so to to read as follows: Re-enacted.

6. At any time hereafter the said trustees, at the instance and upon application of the said Baltimore Annual Conference, or any member or members thereof delegated by said annual conference, by bill, petition or otherwise, may be required to answer individually and personally, and to give account of and concerning the funds aforesaid, and of the interest and incomes proceeding therefrom, to any equity court of the State, and shall be liable to all such orders and decrees in respect of said fund, and the administration thereof as individual trustees are subject to, by the rules and the course of courts of equity; and upon any abuse or incapacity appearing upon any of the proceedings as aforesaid, on the part of any such trustees, said court may remove any such trustee or trustees, and appoint in his or their place, such person or persons as in that behalf shall be recommended to said court by said annual conference; and on a bill or petition as aforesaid, the said court shall have full power to direct and carry into effect and enforce, according to the rules and course of chancery proceedings, the application of said fund, or of the interest or income thereof, according to the provisions and declarations of this act, in respect of the appropriations of the same. Abuse or incapacity

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted,* That the seventh section of the act of eighteen hundred and thirty-four, chapter eighty-seven, be re-enacted so as to read as follows: Re-enacted

7. Whenever the said institution of Dickinson College shall be dissolved, or its operation in its collegiate department shall cease or intermit, or the trustees of said college shall, at any election, or in supplying any vacancy in the board of trustees, so proceed, that a majority of the whole number of said trustees shall not be members of the Methodist Episcopal Church, then the said corporation shall cease Dissolution
