month for each and every month for which he can act as auctioneer under such license.

To keep a correct list

SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That the Treasurer of the State shall keep in his office a correct list of all persons to whom license shall have been granted or assigned under this act, and of the dates when granted, and shall give to the State's Attorney of Baltimore county any information regarding the same which may be requested by him.

In force

SEC. 5. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the first day of May, eighteen hundred and seventy-four.

CHAPTER 474.

AN ACT to protect a class of small birds known as insectivorous birds in Baltimore county and Cecil county.

Unlawful to kill or injure. Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That it shall be unlawful hereafter for any person at any time to shoot, or otherwise kill, or injure, or pursue with such intent, any of the following named birds within the limits of Baltimore county and Cecil county, viz: blue bird, thrush, martin, mocking bird, swallow, oriole, red bird, cat bird, sparrow, whippowill, wren, pewit, goldfinch, sapsucker, ground robin, hanging bird, or woodpecker; provided, that nothing contained in this act shall be so construed as to prevent the killing or capture of crows, black birds, or birds of prey.

Unlawful to

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That it shall be unlawful for any person knowingly and unnecessarily to destroy or disturb the eggs of any of the birds protected by the provisious of this act.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That any person violating any of the provisions of this act, shall on convic-
