CHAPTER 483.

AN ACT to repeal article eighty-one, of the Code of Public General Laws of the State of Maryland, entitled "Revenue and Taxes," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That article eighty-one, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Revenue and Taxes," be and the same is hereby repealed; provided, that said repeal shall not affect or impair any right vested or acquired and existing at the time of said repeal under said article, or any section thereof; nor shall it impair, discharge or release any contract, obligation, duty, liability or penalty whatsoever now existing; but that all suits and actions pending, and all prosecutions for penalties, crimes or misdemeanors under said article, including all civil and criminal proceedings whatsoever, shall be prosecuted and proceeded with to final determination, and judgment entered therein as if said article had not been repealed. Proviso

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That all acts or parts of acts heretofore passed, inconsistent with the provisions of this article as re-enacted, be and the same are hereby repealed. Repealed.

SEC. 3. *And be it further enacted*, That said article eighty-one, be and the same is hereby amended and re-enacted, so as to read as follows: Amended and re-enacted.

SECTION 1. All State and county taxes, and all taxes in the City of Baltimore, shall be levied upon the assessment heretofore made, and such further assessments as may hereafter be made agreeably to law, State and county taxes.
