

Commissioners," of article two of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Anne Arundel county," be and the same is hereby repealed, and the following enacted in lieu thereof:

COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.

SEC. 79. There shall be three County Commissioners for Anne Arundel county, who shall be and they are hereby required to meet in the office of the Board of County Commissioners, in the City of Annapolis, the first Tuesday in each month, and as much oftener as the public interest may require, and shall continue in session at least two days during each session of the circuit court, and one week at their meeting in January, for the purpose of making transfers.

Compensation.

SEC. 80. The said commissioners shall receive four dollars per day each for every day they shall necessarily attend to the duties of their office; provided that no commissioner shall receive a larger sum than three hundred dollars a year; and it shall not be lawful for them to take or receive any gift, consideration, perquisite, mileage or compensation, other than that provided for by this section, in consideration of their services as county commissioners, or because of their action as such.

Shall be ex-  
empt from

SEC. 81. *Be it enacted,* That they shall be exempt from serving as jurors in any of the courts of said county, and it shall not be lawful for the sheriff to summon them as such.

Clerks salary.

SEC. 82. *Be it enacted,* That the clerk to the county commissioners of said county shall receive such salary as they may determine.

Execute a bond

SEC. 83. *Be it enacted,* That he shall, before he enters upon the duties of his office, execute a bond to the State of Maryland in the penalty of five thousand dollars, conditioned for the true and faithful performance of the duties of his office, and the said bond shall be recorded in the office of the clerk of the circuit court of said county.

Oath.

SEC. 84. *Be it enacted,* That he shall also, when appointed, take and subscribe before the said commissioners the following oath: "I, ———, do swear that as Clerk to the County Commissioners of Anne
