

napolis city to constitute the third collection district; said county commissioners shall annually, in the month of March, or as soon as may be practicable, appoint a suitable person for each of these collection districts, to collect the county and State taxes which may be levied in each of these collection districts, nor shall they be interested directly or indirectly in any contract in which the county may be interested.

Compensation. SEC. 3. The said collectors shall receive such compensation as the commissioners may determine, not exceeding six per cent. upon the amount collected, and shall be required to give such bond and be subject to such penalties and liabilities as are now or may hereafter be required by law.

Shall not become surety. SEC. 4. It shall not be lawful for said commissioners to become surety for any person appointed to or holding office under them.

Make such additional levy. SEC. 5. The county commissioners shall, at the usual time of making the levy upon the taxable property of said county, for other State and county purposes, make such additional rate of levy as is now or may hereafter be fixed by law, for the support of free public schools of said county, and may, in their discretion, levy such additional rate as they may deem necessary to promote the efficiency of the said school; said levy for school purposes not to exceed twenty cents on the hundred dollars; the school tax, so fixed by law and levied, in the discretion of said commissioners, to be made separate from the levy for other county and State purposes, and it shall constitute a separate fund, and not to be used for any other purpose but that for which it was levied; and which said school taxes are to be paid directly to the school board of said county, by the collectors of said county.

In force. SEC. 6. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect, except as to the time of election, at the expiration of the time for which the present commissioners were elected.
