

CHAPTER 486.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to pay the claims of Finlay, Roberts and Company, Wm S. Taylor and Company, Henderson's Whf., J. C. Carroll, Klinefelter and Brother, Bolton Brothers, Johnson and Company, J. F. Wiley, Charles Streeper, Brown and Murphy, William A. House, Lewis F. Claby, J. R. Hudgins, Thomas S. Clark and Sons, Anderson and Brothers, and John Murphy and Company.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Comptroller of the Treasury be and he is hereby directed to issue his warrant upon the Treasurer, to pay for material furnished to tobacco warehouse number two, and labor for the same, to Finlay, Roberts and Company, for nails, eight hundred and sixty-three dollars and seventy-four cents; to William S. Taylor and Company, for lumber, one hundred and seventy-five dollars and thirty-nine cents; to Henderson's Wharf for storage, four hundred and ninety dollars; to John K. Carroll for hog-head hoops, three hundred and thirteen dollars and fifty cents; to Klinefelter and Brother, for rope &c., twenty-three dollars and thirty-five cents; to Bolton and Brothers, for paints, one hundred and forty-six dollars and ninety cents; to Johnson and Company, for labor, one hundred and forty-five dollars and twenty cents; to John F. Wiley, for printing, eighty dollars; to Charles Streeper, for hoops, ninety dollars; to Brown and Murphy, for hire of paulins, sixty-five dollars and twenty-five cents; to Wm. A. House, nineteen dollars and sixty-two cents; to Lewis F. Claby, for labor, thirty-six dollars and twenty-five cents; to J. R. Hudgins, for tools, one hundred and thirty-six dollars and seventy-five cents; to Thos. S. Clark and Sons, for labor, twenty-four dollars and six cents; to Anderson and Brother, for tools, three dollars and ninety cents; John Murphy and Company, for a slate, two dollars and fifty cents; which sums of money are hereby appropriated for the purposes aforesaid.
