

CHAPTER 503.

AN ACT to repeal sections fifty-one and fifty-two, of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Prince George county," under the head of collectors, enacted January session, eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, chapter three hundred and thirty, and sections forty-seven and forty-eight of said article sixteen, enacted at January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-two, chapter two hundred and ninety-four, and re-enact the following as sections forty-seven, forty-eight, fifty-one and fifty-two, of said article sixteen, of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Prince George county," under the head of collectors in their stead.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That sections forty-seven and forty-eight, of article sixteen, of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Prince George county," under the head of collectors, passed January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-two, chapter two hundred and ninety-four, and sections fifty-one and fifty-two of said article sixteen, passed January session, eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, chapter three hundred and thirty, be and the same are hereby repealed, and the following re-enacted as sections forty-seven, forty-eight, fifty-one and fifty-two, of said article sixteen, of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Prince George county," under the head of collectors :

47. There shall continue to be a County Treasurer for Prince George county, and that the present County Treasurer of Prince George county, shall continue to hold the office of County Treasurer for Prince George county, for the time for which he was heretofore appointed by section forty-seven, of article sixteen of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Prince George county," under the head of collectors, passed at January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-two, chapter two hundred and ninety-four, and until a successor is elected and qualified ; and at the next general election for Delegates to the
