

Pass by-laws  
and ordinances

SEC. 12. *And be it enacted*, That the said commissioners, or a majority of them, be and they are hereby empowered to pass all by-laws and ordinances necessary to give effect and operation to all the powers vested in this corporation, to impose fines, penalties, and forfeitures for the breach of their by-laws and ordinances; *provided*, that no ordinance of the said commissioners shall impose a fine, penalty, or forfeiture for any one offense of more than ten dollars.

Refuse or neglect to pay

SEC. 13. *And be it enacted*, That if any person or persons shall refuse or neglect to pay their taxes, fines, and forfeitures charged against them by virtue of this act, it shall and may be lawful for said commissioners to collect the same, in the same manner and with the same cost that taxes are generally collected in said county.

Appoint a constable.

SEC. 14. *And be it enacted*, That the County Commissioners of Caroline county be and they are hereby empowered and authorized, to appoint a constable who shall not reside more than two miles from the limits of the said town of Hillsborough, who shall qualify as other constables, and duly perform the functions of said office; *provided*, that he shall at all times be subject to the order of the Board of Town Commissioners of the aforesaid town of Hillsborough.

Taxes, fines  
and forfeitures.

SEC. 15. *And be it enacted*, That all taxes, fines, forfeitures and penalties imposed by the said commissioners by virtue of any law or ordinances, shall be applied in such manner for the use of said town, as may be from time to time by ordinance directed.

In force.

SEC. 16. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
