

dollars; for insurance on the Governor's Mansion, four hundred dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary; to the Librarian for distributing Maryland Reports, one hundred dollars.

**Disburse.** SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the Treasurer of the State shall, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, disburse the said sums of money herein appropriated for the objects and purposes specified, to or upon the order of the person or persons or bodies politic or corporate, severally entitled to receive the same.

**In force.** SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from and after the first day of January, eighteen hundred and seventy-five.

## CHAPTER 512.

AN ACT to repeal sections forty-six, as amended by chapter two hundred and fifty-five, of the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-two, forty-seven, forty-nine, and fifty, as amended by chapter three hundred and eighty-four, of the acts of the General Assembly, passed at January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-two, sixty, sixty-one, and seventy-four of article eighty-one, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "revenue and taxes," in so far as the same may relate to Carroll county, and to enact additional sections to article seven, of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled Carroll county, sub-title "State and county taxes."

**Repealed** SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That sections forty-six, as amended by chapter two hundred and fifty-five, of the acts of the General Assembly, passed at January session, eigh-
