CHAPTER 515.

AN ACT a supplement to an act entitled an act to incorporate a company to make a turnpike road from Hagerstown, in Washington county, to the Pennsylvania Line, passed December session, eighteen hundred and forty-six, chapter three hundred and thirty-three; and to an act entitled a supplement to an act entitled an act to incorporate a company to make a turnpike road from Hagerstown, in Washington county, to the Pennsylvania Line, passed January session, eighteen hundred and sixty-five, chapter two hundred.

Authorized to erect a toll-gate SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That from and after the passage of this act, it shall be lawful for the Hagerstown and Waynesboro Turnpike Company to erect upon their road a toll-gate, at any point on said road not nearer than one mile to the town of Hagerstown; and they are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to remove the toll-gate now situated two miles north-east of Hagerstown on their said road, should they at any time avail themselves of the privileges and powers contained in this section of this act.

Reserves SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the Legislature reserves to itself the right to alter, amend or repeal this act at pleasure.
