Also, repoted favorably

The Senate bill entitled "An Act to appropriate a sum of money to enable the Directors of the Maryland Institution for the instruction of the blind, to pay off an indebtedness against that Institution,"

Was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The Senate bill entitled "An Act to repeal section 15 of Article XXIX. of the Code of Public General Laws, and reenact the same,"

Was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The Senate bill entitled "An Act to repeal sections 1 and 7 of Article XXXVI. of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Estrays, and Vessels adrift,' and to re-enact the same with amendments,"

Was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The Senate bill entitled "An Act to protect rabbits, partridges and insectivorous birds in Baltimore county,"
