Mr. Brattan, from the Committee on Judicial Proceedings, to which leave had been granted, reported a bill entitled "An Act to repeal ec. 146 of Article XVI. of the Code of Public General Laws," title "Chancery, Testimony and Witnesses," authorizing Commissioners taking testimony in Chancery, to issue attachments against witnesses neglecting to attend the summons, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Also,

A bill entitled "An Act to authorize Heshabiah Haines, of Carroll county, to settle his accounts as Guardian to Wm. L. Haines, in the Orphans' Court, of Baltimore city, and to deliver the estate to his said ward."
