The Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal section 67 of Article LI. of the Code of Public General Laws, which was added by Act of 1868, chapter 443, relating to the lien of and executions on judgments of Justices of the Peace, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Endorsed, "Reported unfavorably from the Committee on Judiciary, and the report adopted."

The Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal section 27 of Article X. of the Code of Public General Laws, respecting the sale of "Attached Property," and re-enact the same with amendments.

Endorsed "Reported unfavorably from the Committee on Judiciary, and the report adopted."

The Senate bill entitled an Act to amend and re-enact sections 1, 4, 18 and 58 to 86, inclusive of Article LVI. of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Licenses," to repeal section 19 of said Article and to add further sections to said Article, regulating the sale of intoxicating liquors.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.

Mr. Stevens, from the Committee on Judicial Proceedings, reported.

The Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal section 38 of the Act passed 9th of March, 1864, chapter 306, entitled an Act to add new sections to Article X. of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Attachments," providing for attachments on original process and to re-enact the same with amendments.
