A bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact section 22, of Article LIII. of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Landlord and Tenant," also to repeal chapter 279, of the Acts of 1870, entitled an Act to amend the Act of Assembly of 1868, chapter 292, adding and additional section to Article LIII. of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Landlord and Tenant," by repealing and re-enacting the same.
