The House bill entitled an Act giving the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to a certain legacy bequeathed by the last will and testament of *Susan Welty*, to the German Baptist Church, commonly called "*Welty's Church.*"

The House bill entitled an Act to appropriate certain fines to purchasing a law library in the place of the one destroyed by fire, for the Circuit Court for Washington county.

The House bill entitled an Act to protect wild fowl in Worcester county.
