The Senate bill entitled an Act for the relief of Noah Webster, of Somerset county.

Mr. Tuck, from the Committee on Judicial Proceedings, reported

The Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments, the fifth section of Article XXXVII. of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Evidence," as amended by the Act of 1864, chapter 109.

Also, reported

The Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal section 5 of chapter 381 of the Act of 1872, so far as it relates to Prince George's county, entitled an Act to provide for the destruction of Hawks and Owls, and to protect the class of small birds, known as insectivorous birds, in Prince George's, Talbot and Montgomery counties.

The Senate bill entitled an Act to amend Article XXXVII. section forty-two of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Evidence," and relating to the probate of accounts.

The Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal section 43 of Article XXXVII. entitled "Evidence," and sub-title "Domestic accounts of the Public General Laws relating to probate accounts," and re-enact the same with amendments.

The Senate bill entitled an Act to punish defendants in attachments and executions who may clandestinely remove or dispose of property levied upon for debt by Sheriffs and Constables.
