Reported unfavorably on the Senate bill entitled "An Act to authorize the County Commissioners for Fredrick county, to revise and correct the valuation of the property in said county, assessed to John W. Whitmore, George J. Himmel and Joseph McCoskery."

Said report was adopted.

Also,

Reported favorably on the bill entitled "An Act for the support and treatment of indigent patients in the Baltimore Eye and Ear Institute for Baitimore city."

Which was read the first time.

On motion by Mr. Claggett,

Leave was granted to Messrs Claggett, Phelps and Crawford to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to authorize the Mayor and Council of Hagerstown to borrow the sum of five thousand dollars, to pay a judgment of Nathaniel Lehner, and a judgment of J. G. Gruber, recovered against them, to issue bonds for the payment of the same, and to levy taxes on the assessable property of Hagerstown to redeem said bonds and to pay the interest thereon."
