The Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal Article XCVIII. of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Wild Fowl," and also to repeal an Act passed at January Session, 1872, chapter 54, entitled an Act to exempt all that portion of the waters of the Chesapeake Bay, lying northward of a certain line therein described, from the operations and effects of sections 1 and 3 of Article XCVIII. of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Wild Fowl," and to enact other sections to be in force and operation in, on and over said waters, and to re-enact said Article XCVIII., entitled "Wild Fowl," with amendments.

And the report was adopted.

Leave was granted to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings to report a bill to repeal an Act to add an additional section to Article XXX. of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to "Crimes and Punishments," sub-title "Embezzeling Property," passed January Session 1872, chapter 423.

The House bill entitled an Act to add new sections to Article XXII. of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to "Worcester county" to be sub-titled "sales of Spirituous or Fermented Liquors."

Mr. Aydelott moved to substitute the bill for the unfavorable report.
