

The House bill entitled an Act to add certain sub-sections to Article XIX. of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Somerset County," under sub-title "Licenses," and to repeal section one hundred and thirty-eight of said Article, entitled "Somerset County," under sub-title "Retailers."

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Brattan, Tuck and Steiner.

Also,

The House bill entitled an Act to repeal chapter 347 of the Acts passed January Session, 1872, entitled an Act to repeal sections 141, 142, 143, 144, 145, 146, 147, 148, 149, 150, 151, 152, 153, 154, 155, 156, 157, 158, 159, 160, 161, 162, 163 and 164 of Article VIII. of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Cecil County," and relating to Port Deposit, and to re-enact the same with amendments, and to provide for taking the sense of the qualified voters of Port Deposit, whether or not said repeal and re-enactments with amendments, shall go into effect or be utterly void.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Knight, Longwell and Brewer.
