Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations to introduce a bill entitled an Act to repeal Article XXI., section 7 of an Act entitled an Act to create State Banking Institutions, and to enable the several Banks of this State (State and National) to avail of the provisions thereof, passed at January Session, 1870, chapter 206, and to impose a tax on the issue of notes put in circulation by State Banking Institutions.

On motion by Mr. Brattan,

The Committee on Judicial Proceedings were discharged from further consideration of sundry petitions praying that the law may be so changed as to abolish the death penalty.

Mr. Steiner, from a Select Committee, reported favorably on

The House bill entitled an Act to amend section 18 of an Act passed at January Session, 1868, chapter 195, entitled an Act to incorporate the Emmitsburg Rail Road Company.

Mr. Crawford, from a Select Committee, reported favorably on

The House bill entitled an Act to repeal chapter 189 of the Acts of 1872, relating to Salisbury Academy, and re-enact the same with amendments.

Which was read the second time.

Mr. Longwell, from a Select Committee, reported favorably on

The House bill entitled an Act to amend further the Act entitled an Act to incorporate the Baltimore and Liberty Turnpike Company in Carroll county, passed at January Session, 1866, and as amended by the Act of 1868, chapter 151, changing the name of said corporation to that of the Baltimore, Carroll and Liberty Turnpike Road Company, of Carroll and Frederick counties, and to repeal sections 2 and 3 of the Act of 1870, chapter 232, and to re-enact the said sections 2 and 3 with amendments.

Which was read the second time.

Mr. Davis, from a Select Committee, reported favorably on
