The House bill entitled an Act authorizing and directing the State Librarian to furnish to the Faculty of Law, of the University of Maryland, certain Law Books.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on the Library.

The Senate bill entitled an Act to regulate the number of Justices of the Peace and Constables for Garrett county.

Endorsed, "Passed by yeas and nays, with proposed amendment.

## AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Section 1. Strike out all after the word "Constable," in line 7, and insert the following in lieu thereof: "For Election District Number 5, two Justices of the Peace and one Constable; for Election District Number 6, two Justices of the Peace and one Constable; for Election District Number 7, two Justices of the Peace and two Constables; for Election District Number 8, two Justices of the Peace and one Constable; for Election District Number 9, one Justice of the Peace and one Constable, and that the Governor, be and is hereby authorized and empowered to appoint and commission such Justices of the Peace."
