Endorsed, "Reported unfavorably from the Committee on Judiciary and the report adopted."

The Senate bill entitled an Act to refund to Ellen Havel, of Cecil county, a sum of money erroneously demanded of her by the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Cecil county, for a license, and paid by said Clerk into the Treasury.
