The House bill entitled an Act to authorize the Commissioners of Wicomico county to levy taxes on the assessable property of said county for the purpose of purchasing a site on which to erect a Court House and Jail, and furnish the same,

Reported said bill with the following amendment:

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

At the end of section 2, add the words: "And the said County Commissioners are hereby prohibited, and it shall be unlawful for them to contract for said site, or the erection of a Jail, or the erection and furnishing of said Court House and offices, until the levy shall have been made for the several purposes set forth in this section respectively."

Which was adopted.

Said bill, as amended, was read the second time.
