The Senate bill entitled an Act for the taxation of Dogs in the State of Maryland.

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Stevens, from the Committee on Corporations, reported

The Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal Article XXI. of section 7 of an Act entitled an Act to create State Banking Institutions, and to enable the several banks of this State (State and National) to avail of the provisions thereof, passed at January Session, 1870, chapter 206, and to impose a tax on the issue of notes put in circulation by State Banks and Banking Institutions.

Which was read the first time.

Also, reported

The Senate bill entitled an Act to amend Article XXVI. of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, entitled "Corporations," as enacted and amended by the General Assembly of Maryland, by an Act passed at the January Session, 1868, chapter 471, by adding thereto the following sections, to follow section 219 of said Article, and to be numbered 220, 221, 222 and 223, relating to Building and Homestead Associations, Loan and Land Companies.
