The House bill entitled an Act to repeal chapter 347 of the Acts passed January Session, 1872, entitled an Act to repeal sections 141, 142, 143, 144, 145, 146, 147, 148, 149, 150, 151, 152, 153, 154, 155, 156, 157, 158, 159, 160, 161, 162, 163, and 164 of Article VIII. of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Cecil County," and relating to Port Deposit, and to re-enact the same with amendments, and to provide for taking the sense of the qualified voters of Port Deposit, whether or not said repeal and re-enactments with amendments, shall go into effect, or be utterly void.
