Which was adopted.

Also, the following amendment:

Strike out the word "the" and insert the word "all," in the 7th line of section 11; make the word "amount," read "amounts," on same line and section, and after the word "received," add the words "by them," and make the word "source," to read "sources."

Which was adopted.

Also, the following amendment:

Add the word "to," after the word "notify," in 2nd line, 12th section.

Which was adopted.

Also, the following amendment:

After the word "officers," in 9th line of 13th section, add the following: "Which said officers are hereby required to furnish."

Which was adopted.

Mr. Tuck submitted the following amendment:

"If the accommodations at the Institute shall be sufficent, and if not, then they shall send a pro rata number according to the provisions of this Act."

Which was adopted.

Mr. Davis submitted the following amendment:

"In the 3rd line of section 18, strike out "mill and oneeighth of a mill" and insert the following: "cent and onefifth of a cent."

Which was adopted.

Also, the following amendment:

"In the 4th line of section 11, fill the blank space with the words 'one mill and one-fifth of a mill."

Which was adopted.

Mr. Williams moved to refer the bill to the Committee on Finance.

Which was rejected.

Mr. Earle submitted the following amendment:

"And that all bonds issued in pursuance of this Act shall be exempt from State, County and Municipal Taxation."

Which was rejected.
