

tion on account of any beneficial enjoyment by the owners of such property, from the time of making of the assessment, and may also recover any other special damages that may be proved to have arisen from said proceedings; provided, that the provisions of sections 83 and 84, shall not apply to the condemnations heretofore made for the improvement of Jones' Falls in the city of Baltimore, unless, and until the Ordinance of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, providing for the issue of additional bonds to the amount of one million five hundred thousand dollars, for said improvement, shall have been approved by the voters of the said city, at the election provided for in said ordinance; and provided further, that in case of the approval of said ordinance as aforesaid, then the said provisions shall apply to such condemnations, unless within ninety days thereafter, the said Mayor and City Council of Baltimore shall abandon said condemnations as aforesaid.

Section 3. And be it enacted, That no rights which may have accrued under the section hereby repealed and re-enacted shall be in any way affected by this Act.
