

On motion by Mr. Stevens,

The Senate proceeded to the consideration of bills on second and third reading.

The Senate bill entitled an Act to declare the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to the bequest and devise of Charles Spates, late of Montgomery county, deceased, to the Trustees of the Baptist Church, at Rockville, in Montgomery county, Maryland,

Was read the third time and passed by yeas and nays as follows :

Being on second reading,

Strike out the words "to be exempt from taxation," in the — line of section —.

Section 1, line 8, strike out after the word "Maryland," to "and shall," in the 9th line.

Which was adopted.

Also, the following amendment :

Strike out "city of Baltimore," in 15th line of section 3.

Which was adopted.

Also, the following amendment :

Section 4, line 28, strike out the words "and twenty-five."

Which was adopted.

Said bill, as amended, was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
