bill entitled "An Act to repeal section 806, of Article IV., of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to the city of Baltimore," entitled "Police," and to re-enact in lieu thereof another section as section 806.

Which was read the first time and ordered to be printed.

Leave was granted to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings to introduce a bill adding a new section to Article LI., Code of Public General Laws, to follow section 45, to provide for the supersedeas of judgments of affirmance, or de novo judgments, on appeal from Justices of the Peace.
