the responsibility with the Legislature to take the necessary steps to provide for the absolute requirements of the Treasury.

Mr. Williams, from a Select Committee, reported favorably The House bill in relation to Public Roads in Calvert county, with an amendment:

## AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Strike out the title and insert in lieu thereof, "A bill entitled an Act supplementary to an Act passed January Session, eighteen hundred and seventy-two, entitled an Act to provide for the repair and improvement of the Public Roads of Calvert county.

"Section 3. And be it it enacted, That whenever the County Commissioners of said county, have reason to believe that any public road in said county has ceased to be used as a public highway, it shall be competent for the said County Commissioners to appoint three discreet and sensible men residing in the neighborhood of said public road, who shall be directed to examine said road, and to report to said County Commissioners whether, in their opinion, it will be advisable.

"Section 3. And be it enacted, That whenever the County Commissioners of said county, have reason to believe that any public road in said county has ceased to be used as a public highway, it shall be competent for the said County Commissioners to appoint three discreet and sensible men residing in the neighborhood of said public road, who shall be directed to examine said road, and to report to said County Commissioners.
