In line 6, strike out the letters "ies," at the end of counties.

Line 7, strike out the word "thirty," and insert "five," and in line 8, strike out the word "sixty," and insert "ten."

Section 2, line 1, after the word "of," strike out "each of," in line 2, strike out the word "counties," and insert "county."

Section 5, line 6, after the word "Peace," strike out "of each," and in same line "counties," and insert "county."

Same section, line 9, strike out "each of said counties," and insert "county."

Section 9, line 6, after the words "Commissioners of," strike out "each of said counties respectively," and insert "said county."

Which were severally adopted.
