Failed to pass for want of a constitutional majority.

Which was adopted.

Mr. Stevens submitted the following amendment:

Amend the title by adding "And to appropriate a sum of money to the College of Physicians and Surgeons, of Baltimore, and a sum of money for the Hebrew Hospital of Baltimore.
