voting for or against said annexation, shall be for annexation, then the said part of Baltimore county within the bounds and courses described in this Act, shall become and constitute a part or portion of Baltimore city, and the Governor shall issue his proclamation to that effect, and the inhabitants thereof shall thenceforth enjoy all the rights and privileges now held and enjoyed by the citizens of Baltimore city."
