Be it Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That a Joint Special Committee of three on part of the Senate, and four on part of the House of Delegates, be appointed, to request the Committee appointed under the Act of the General Assembly, A. D. 1867, chapter 51, to appear in the Hall of the House of Delegates, on the 17th day of March next, and that the Joint Committee be also authorized to secure the services of some distinguished citizen of Maryland, to deliver an oration on the life and public services of the late Chief Justice.

And be it further Resolved, That the said Special Committee be instructed to invite the Governor, the Judges of the Court of Appeals, and other high officials of the State, the Justices of the Supreme Court of the United States, as also the family and relations of the late Chief Justice, to be present on the occasion.
