The House bill entitled an Act authorizing the Commissioners of Anne Arundel county, to settle the accounts of Thomas Berry and others.

The House bill entitled an Act to license Hucksters, in Washington county.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Claggett, Phelps and Crawford.

The House bill entitled an Act authorizing the city of Baltimore, at its discretion, to purchase the property of the Western Maryland Rail Road Company.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Baltimore City Senators.

The House bill entitled an Act amending the charter of the city of Cumberland.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. McCulloh, Lloyd and Walsh.

The House bill entitled an Act to provide for the passage of locomotives, cars, passengers and freights over connecting railroads, in the State of Maryland.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Internal Improvements.

The House bill entitled an Act to authorize the Commissioners of Baltimore county, to grant rights-of-way through the jail lot of said county, to the Towsontown Rail Road Company, and to the Maryland and Pennsylvania Rail Road Company.
