dollars, due for pensions for the years 1870, 1871, 1872 and 1873.

Which was read the first time and referred to Committee on Pensions.

The House bill entitled an Act to add two additional sections to Article LVIII. Code of Public General Laws, title "Lunatics and Insane."

The House bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 2 and 6 of Article LIII. of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Landlord and Tenant," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

The House bill entitled an Act to provide for recording judgments of Justices of the Peace, for making them liens upon real estate and chattels, real, and to provide for the issuing of executions and scire facias thereon, when so recorded.
